In Memory of Council Member Albert P. Mendoza

WHEREAS, Albert P. Mendoza proudly served the City of Tolleson, his beloved community, as Council Member for 15 years; and

WHEREAS, in this role, he collaborated with other City Council Members, businesses, community organizations and citizens to provide clear leadership for the growth and sustainability of the City of Tolleson; and

WHEREAS, as Council Member, he was instrumental in the decision-making processes and was committed to protect and promote the best interests for all Tolleson's residents; and

WHEREAS, he was born on April 16, 1948 to Gumesindo, Sr. and Mercedes Mendoza in Phoenix, Arizona, and he attended Tolleson Elementary School and Tolleson Union High School; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mendoza was married to his beautiful wife Cruzita for 48 years, and they raised two wonderful sons, Michael Albert and Richard Reginald in Tolleson; and

WHEREAS, in addition to being a husband, father and grandfather, he had a 40-year career as a barber and owned three shops, served as President of the West End Little League, in addition to coaching both of his sons, and as a Parish Council Member of Blessed Sacrament Church; and

WHEREAS, as a strong proponent of service to people, he served his country in the United States Army for three years, earning his general education degree; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mendoza was known by the community as T-Town Al, for his contagious humor and for always being just one phone call away.
